

PROFILE: HU YONG—China's Leading Internet Authority



Hu Yong is Executive Board Director, Editor-in-Chief, and Senior Executive Vice President of Media Strategy for ChinaValue.net, the No. 1 Business/Economics/Finance new media community/portal/blog channel in China.

Hu Yong received a B.A. in economics from the Shanghai International Studies University, and an M.A. in journalism from the Chinese Academy of Social Sciences. Currently, he is a Ph.D. candidate in politics at the prestigious Renmin University of China. In 2006 and returning in May 2007, Hu was invited as a visiting scholar to the prestigious University of California at Berkeley as the leading authority on China and the Internet. Hu is an acknowledged world authority on China industry and the ways they differ from their Western counterparts providing key business intelligence.

For two years from 1991, he was a national news editor with the China Daily, China's only national English-language daily newspaper. For another two years beginning in 1993, he was a researcher with the International Trade and Economic Cooperation Research Institute under the Ministry of Foreign Trade and Economic Cooperation, where he was engaged in research involving the development of strategies for growth in changing markets. In 1995, he joined Lifeweek, the most prestigious newsmagazine in China, as a senior writer and columnist. He commented on important business developments, with a special focus on the information industry.

From 1999 to 2001, he was Chairman of the Editorial Board of China Internet Weekly, the most authoritative weekly on China's Internet economy, and President of the China Internet Institute, the leading think tank on Internet

research and consulting in China. In 2001, he went on to found the Global Executive, a management journal that explores the “Tao” of management in the ever-changing business and technological world. In 2002, he joined China Central Television Channel II, China's No.1 business news channel, as a Producer and Chief Strategist. Seen by nearly 100 million viewers every day, CCTV Channel II is the most-watched and longest-running broadcast business news channel.

Hu Yong is highly regarded as China’s most powerful thinker in helping organizations leverage their managerial capacity in Internet environments.

Hu Yong is a widely quoted and highly influential writer for his early insights into industry trends, his witty commentaries and his thorough analysis of challenging subjects. He has extensive research and consulting experience.

The most respected authority in his field, Hu Yong has been published widely. He authored “Internet: The King Who Rules,” the first book introducing the Internet to Chinese readers, as well as several other best-selling books concerning the Internet economy. He is also the translator of several groundbreaking English books on digital

technology, including “Being Digital, Release 2.0: A Design for Living in the Digital Age” and “City of Bits: Space, Place and Infobahn.” All these monographs and translations are well received for their timeliness and insight and have greatly helped open the new era of the popularization and commercialization of the Internet in China. His most recent book is “Haier: China-made” is a classic case study about the rise of a legendary Chinese manufacturing giant.

A frequent speaker at IT events and management conferences, Hu Yong is active in industry affairs. He is co-founder of the influential Digital Forum of China, the leading nonprofit organization that promotes the public awareness of digitalization and advocates freedom as well as responsibilities of the Internet. In 2000, as validation of Hu’s prominence in China, Mr. Yong was the nominee as the Top Chinese Internet Authority. As another example of his considerable influence, in June 2005, Hu hosted the Nobel-Prize Winner Forum.
